DESCRIPTION: Transfer of Service With Delinquent
and/or Outstanding Balance

PURPOSE

The purpose of this policy is to establish guidelines for the amount due from a customer who applies for and requests the transfer of service(s) into his/her name for premises at which there is a delinquent and/or outstanding balance for the payment of charges for services from any system or facility of the Limestone County Water & Sewer Authority (hereinafter "the Authority") to such premises.

POLICY

Upon receipt of an application and request for the transfer of the account of service(s) at any premises into the name of the applicant, the amount payable to complete transfer of service(s) applied for and requested shall include (1) all connection fees and deposits required for the desired service(s) and (2) any delinquent and/or outstanding balance for service(s) at any such premises. NOTE: if the immediately preceding customer for such premises was a builder, developer, or realtor, then the total in item (2) will include any delinquent and/or outstanding balance for water service consumption and/or sewer service consumption.

The Authority reserves the right to decline to accept any payment of charges for service(s) at the premises that does not include payment of charges for any other service(s) at the same premises as described in the preceding paragraphs.

The Authority reserves the right to discontinue and/or disconnect service(s) at any premises at which there is a delinquency in the payment of charges for service(s) at said premises, which discontinuance and/or disconnection from service(s) may be conducted as provided for by the policies of the Authority or as otherwise may be provided by law.
